OPENING HYMN "Baptismal Waters Cover Me"

OPENING LITURGY

- P: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.
- C: Amen.
- P: Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death?
- C: We were buried therefore with Him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life.
- P: God is light, and in Him is no darkness at all. If we say we have fellowship with Him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.
- C: But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.

Moment of Silent Confession

- P: Let us confess our sins to God our Father.
- C: God our Father, though You have made us Your own possession by our Baptism into Christ, still we struggle to live as Your redeemed children in this fallen world. Therefore, we confess our sin and weakness to You and in repentance pray You of Your mercy to forgive our sins and grant us Your grace and strength.
- P: Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of Christ, and by His authority, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C: Amen.

- P: Ascribe to the LORD, O heavenly beings, ascribe to the LORD glory and strength.
- C: Ascribe to the LORD the glory due His name; worship the LORD in the splendor of holiness.
- P: The voice of the LORD is over the waters:
- C: the God of glory thunders, the LORD, over many waters.
- P: The voice of the LORD is powerful; the voice of the LORD is full of majesty.
- C: The voice of the LORD breaks the cedars; the LORD breaks the cedars of Lebanon.
- P: He makes Lebanon to skip like a calf, and Sirion like a young wild ox.
- C: The voice of the LORD flashes forth flames of fire.
- P: The voice of the LORD is over the waters;
- C: the God of glory thunders, the LORD, over many waters.
- P: The voice of the LORD shakes the wilderness; the LORD shakes the wilderness of Kadesh.
- C: The voice of the LORD makes the deer give birth and strips the forests bare, and in His temple all cry, "Glory!"
- P: The LORD sits enthroned over the flood; the LORD sits enthroned as king forever.
